This only works when parents volunteer their houses on a rotating basis for children to study. 2. There will not be outside distractions such as other children coming in and out of the room or TV noise.
3. The area where the children will be studying is large enough for them to sit comfortably and for our teachers to have an easel and white board for teaching.
